FINAL INSTRUCTIONS - DIJON MOTORS CUP

Track: 3,800 km

Circuit / Paddock / Pit garages Access:

Thursday, 5th October from 14:00 to 19:30

Friday, 6th October from 07:45 to 19:00

Competitors will have to leave the paddock and the pit garages at the latest on Sunday 8/10 at 19:00 and will be able to park on the P4 car park until Monday 9/10.

Out of respect for the spectators, it will not be possible to dismantle the structures, nor to collect the trailers before 13:00 on Sunday.

Welcome Competitors office: located at the entrance to the paddock, on the ground floor of the Tower control. You can come and collect your practice tickets, extra pass, extra tickets... **Opening:** Thursday from 14:00 to 20:00, Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 to 19:00.

Signing on will take place in the Welcome Office.

Drivers' briefings: Please refer to the briefing schedule for your set. They will take place on the first floor of the Pit Building.

Scrutineering will take place in situ (Paddock or Pit garages of each competitor), on Friday from 8:30 up to 2 hours before the briefing. Competitors must stay close to their car during this day in order to be at the disposal of scrutineers.

Wristband:

Grids 1-2-3-4-6-8-9 : 4 passes / car

Grid 5-7 : 5 passes / car

The wristband will be given during the signing on. Competitors can buy additional pass at the preferential rate (15€/week-end) before Tuesday, October, 3rd on www.hvmracing.fr section « [Dijon Motors Cup](#) ».

Testings: Sessions are available on Friday. It is advised to book your session online in order to have the discount price, before Tuesday, October, 3rd at 9:00 on www.hvmracing.fr section « [Dijon Motors Cup](#) » secured Payment by Credit Card.

Stands: (12m x 5m) : Only available by pre-booking using our website « [Dijon Motors Cup](#) », (Rental price: 600 € VAT inc ./week-end, Deposit : 300€ CB only. Keys will be given at the welcome office of the circuit (podium building) on Thursday from 14:00 to 19:00 and Friday from 8:00 to 18:00.

Paddock: Only trucks, trailers and racing cars are allowed in the paddock. Personal cars must be parked in the competitors' car park. All trailers, camping cars and motorhomes will be parked in their dedicated area.

Licences: Each driver must hold at least a national competitor/driver licence (depending on the stage). Foreign drivers holding a national licence must present an authorisation to participate abroad issued by their ASN. It is also possible to take out licences for the weekend (participation tickets) by presenting a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of motor sport, less than 6 months old, and a copy of the driving licence. The 2023 rates are : TPNVHCC: 36€ ASA fee + 139€ payable to ASA Classic. Entry tickets are to be made at the competitor's desk.

What can I do?



Lake Kir

N 5, 21000 DIJON

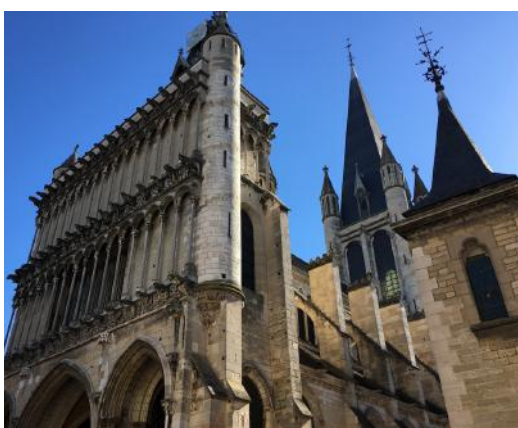
The memory of the famous Canon, a roguish clergyman, who not only gave his name to a famous apéritif but also took a particular interest in water: he was responsible for the creation of this 37ha stretch of water, a favourite with the people of Dijon for leisure activities such as walking, fishing and swimming as well as various nautical pleasures.



Well of Moses

1 BOULEVARD DU CHAN-KIR, 21000 DIJON

This gem of medieval sculpture can be found in the centre of the former large cloister of the charterhouse of Champmol, founded by Philip the Bold in 1383 and destroyed for the most part in 1793. The well of Moses is one of the rare remaining features of the medieval monastery. The small edifice houses six strikingly life-like statues of prophets by the sculptor, Claus Sluter, also responsible for the chapel portal. The edifice is named after the figure of Moses, perhaps the most impressive of the group.



Dijon's Church of Our Lady

PLACE NOTRE-DAME, 21000 DIJON

Built between 1230 and 1250, this fine Gothic church stands on a relatively cramped spot, which forced the architect to achieve veritable technical miracles. The façade sports three rows of amusing gargoyles. In the right-hand tower, a Jacquemart family of automatons strikes the hour. The exceedingly harmonious interior of the church is worth a visit.



Palace of the Dukes and States of Burgundy

PLACE DE LA LIBÉRATION, 21000 DIJON

The palace buildings bear witness to their functions over the course of history: residence of the Dukes of Burgundy, seat of the governor of the representative provincial assembly under the Ancien Régime, art school (at the origin of the museum) and town hall of Dijon. Birthplace of the Grand Dukes of the West, the palace is now the site of the town hall and the city's Museum of Fine Arts. The lavish hall of the tombs of the Dukes of Burgundy provides a splendid introduction to the history of Burgundy.



Magnin Museum

4 RUE DES BONS-ENFANTS, 21000 DIJON

The museum's paintings were curated from 1890 to 1938 by a magistrate, Maurice Magnin, and his sister, Jeanne, an art critic. Their aim was to collect paintings by unknown yet talented painters. The collection, boasts some 1 500 paintings by Flemish, Italian and French artists, and works by Old Masters (Tiepolo, Géricault) rub shoulders with less well-known artists, all of which within the walls of an elegant 17C mansion.



Dijon Archeology Museum

5 RUE DU DR-MARET, 21000 DIJON

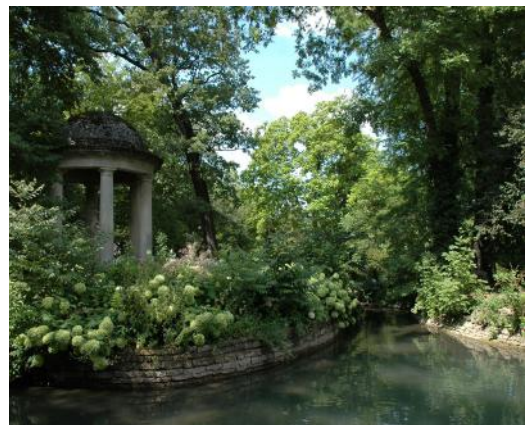
The museum is in the Abbaye de St Bénigne, in the east wing of the abbey's missing cloister. It showcases regional collections from prehistory to the Middle Ages. Fine Romanesque rooms display Gallo-Roman sculptures, including a statuette of the goddess Sequana. The former monks' dormitory is dedicated to medieval sculpture, an attractive frieze depicts the mother-goddesses of Alesia, and 5C-6C Merovingian sarcophagi occupy the square. Pieces dating from the 14C and 19C have also been unearthed.



St Bénigne's Cathedral

6 BIS RUE DANTON, 21000 DIJON

Under the porchway of the cathedral, crowned by a small open-work gallery, the framework of the old Romanesque doorway has been preserved in the Gothic façade. The Romanesque crypt reveals part of the transept with four apsidioles. In a recess are the remains of the sarcophagus of St Bénigne, Burgundy's first martyr. This burial place opposite a large opening gives onto the lower floor of the rotonda whose architecture reprises Christ's tomb in Jerusalem.



Jardin de l'Arquebuse

1 AV. ALBERT-1er, 21000 DIJON

A stone's throw from Dijon Station, the huge Arquebuse Park - dedicated to the natural sciences, the earth and the universe - boasts numerous sites of interest: the museum housed in the Arquebuse pavilion; the botanical garden; and the Hubert Curien planetarium, where the infinite spectacle of the heavens may be observed beneath its 10m-diameter dome.



Château du Clos de Vougeot
21640 VOUGEOT

The Château du Clos de Vougeot can be seen from afar, rising in the middle of vineyards. Built during the Renaissance by Abbot Loisier, it was restored in the 19C. The tour includes the great cellar (12C), where the ceremonies of the Tastevin Brotherhood take place every year, the wine-making cellar (12C) with its four giant winepresses dating back to “the monks’ time” and the former kitchen (16C) located under a vault resting on a single central column. The visit ends with the lay brothers’ dormitory with its spectacular 14C timberwork.



Château de Marsannay
2 RUE DES VIGNES 21160 MARSANNAY

Château de Marsannay is located at the gates of Dijon city at the heart of the vineyards, offering a magnificent view on the Clos de Jeu plot. Château de Marsannay suggests guided tastings upon request, including a visit of the double arched wine cellars built in a Cistercian style.



Château de Pommard
15 RUE MAREY MONGE, 21630 POMMARD

Made by Nature in France. Every year, consumers and professionals from more than 80 countries around the world visit Château de Pommard to learn about the world of wine from Wine and Spirit Education Trust (WSET) professionals and taste the purest expressions of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from villages along the Route des Grands Crus. From the grape to the glass, guests experience Clos Marey-Monge, a geological marvel, and home to seven distinct clay and limestone rich plots, now protected as one of the world heritage Climats of Burgundy by UNESCO. Founded in 1726, Château de Pommard combines three hundred years of savoir-faire and the innovative vision of the Famille Carabello-Baum for the future. Wine lovers and critics agree the conversion to biodynamic viticulture is producing honest, energetic wines infused with an unmistakable sense of place while preserving the planet where we all live.



Domaine Michel Magnien
4 RUE RIBORDOT, 21220 MOREY-SAINT-DENIS
