



## FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

October 3-4-5, 2025

Track : 3,800 km

### Circuit / Paddock / Pit garages Access :

Thursday, 2nd October from 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm

Friday, 3rd October from 7:45 am to 7:00 pm

Competitors must leave the paddock and boxes by 7:00 pm on Sunday 5/10 at the latest and may park in car park P4 until Monday 6/10.

Out of respect for spectators, it will not be possible to dismantle structures or collect trailers before 1:00 pm on Sunday.

**Welcome Competitors office** : located at the entrance to the paddock, on the ground floor of the Tower control. You can come and collect your practice tickets, extra pass, extra tickets...

**Opening** : Thursday from 2:00 pm to 7:30 pm, Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm.

**Signing on will** take place in the Welcome Office. As soon as you arrive at the circuit, please complete the necessary administrative formalities.

**Drivers' briefings** : Please refer to the briefing schedule for your set. They will take place on the first floor of the Pit Building.

**Scrutineering** will take place in situ (Paddock or Pit garages of each competitor), on Friday from 8:00 am up to 2 hours before the briefing. Competitors must stay close to their car during this day in order to be at the disposal of scrutineers.

### **Access & Pass :**

4 passes / car and for the 300km race : 6 pass/ car

Wristbands will be distributed at the administrative checks. Additional accreditations (€20/weekend) can be purchased online before Tuesday September, 30 at [www.hvmracing.fr](http://www.hvmracing.fr) under the 'Dijon Motors Cup' heading.

**Testings** : sessions are organised on Fridays. It is advisable to book the sessions in advance to ensure you have enough space and to benefit from the preferential rate. Online bookings before 9.00 am on Wednesday October 1 on 'Dijon Motors Cup' heading, with secure payment by credit card. Please note that the price is slightly higher on site.

**Pit garages** (12m x 5m) : To be booked online on 'Dijon Motors Cup', (Rental price: €650 incl. VAT/weekend, Deposit: €300 credit card payment. Keys can be collected from the circuit reception desk (podium building) on Thursday from 4pm to 7.30 pm and on Friday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. An inventory of fixtures will be carried out with the circuit team.



**Paddock** : Only service vehicles and race cars are allowed in the paddock. Private cars are not allowed in the paddock and must be parked in the competitor's car park from Thursday. Trailers and camper vans must be parked in a reserved area.

**Licences** : Each driver must hold at least one national competitor's/driver's licence. Foreign drivers holding a national licence must present a foreign participation authorisation issued by their ASN. It is also possible to take out licences for the weekend (participation tickets) by presenting a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of motor sport, less than 6 months old, and a copy of the driving licence. The 2024 fees are as follows: TPNVHCC. €43 ASA fee + €147 payable to ASA Classic. Entry tickets must be picked up at the competitor reception desk.

**Transponders** : All competitors must be equipped with Chronolec / Tag Heuer Elite type transponders or ITS Chrono Cobra 360 type transponders on sale here. The transponders can be hired from the timekeeper during the races at a cost of €60 per meeting (deposit: €300 in cheque or cash). **Trackwalk** : Thursday 2 October from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm, on foot only (no motorised vehicles, bikes or scooters).

**Gridwalk** : Saturday 4 October from 1:05 pm to 1:25pm F2 Classic Interseries grid and Sunday 5 October from 2:15 pm to 2:35 pm for the F3 classic interseries grid.

**Drivers Club** : Enjoy the Saturday races in a lounge on the circuit with terrace and panoramic view for €95 incl. VAT. SATURDAY AND/OR SUNDAY
